The 2008 Australian Body Art Carnivale will be held in Eumundi on Saturday 20 and Sunday 21 September. Australia's premier body art competition, the Australian Body Art Carnivale will be a "Festival of Colour" drawing together cutting-edge artists from around the globe, who will create masterpieces before your eyes using the human body as their inspiration – and canvas!

A highlight of the weekend will be a **Wearable Art** fashion parade on Sunday 21 September – showcasing original designs created from reused or secondhand materials. It's an opportunity to tap into the incredible imagination of established designers, as well as talented 'up and coming' young designers carving their niche in the world of fashion.

Entrants can either create their design independently, or team up with other fashionistas and create a work of Wearable Art together.

Judges will be looking for creative edge and originality of material, so "think outside the square" when brainstorming your Wearable Art design. Creations do not have to be practical or commercially viable; they just have to be WEARABLE. The possibilities are limitless!

### **Terms and Conditions of Entry**

1. Each garment must be made from product/material that has had a “life” or use before. Only cotton, zips, bias binding, etc may be new.
2. The garment must be wearable.
3. All entries must include a drawing of the intended design (you will not be judged on your drawing capabilities) along with a paragraph about your design, including a brief outline of the materials you intend to use.
4. Entrants are required to supply a model for the rehearsal on 31 August, and the fashion parade (and judging) on 21 September. Entrants and models must remain until the judges’ decisions are announced.
5. All entrants need to understand the judges’ decisions are final and cannot be contested.
6. Entry fees are non-refundable.
